passage (noun) : a long narrow area

: people who illegally hunt animals poachers (noun)

Poachers hunt elephants for their tusks.

roams (verb) : walks around an area without any definite aim or direction

sturdy (adjective) : strong and not easily damaged

The boats look sturdy enough to be used at sea.

trapped (verb) : caught an animal in a place and prevented it from escaping

He trapped the mouse in the mouse trap.

trench (noun) : a long deep hole dug in the ground

An elephant was trapped in the trench made by poachers.
