Read the passage and answer the questions

2. The king of rats, Mooshakraj went to the king of elephants Gajraj, and promised to take his herd through another route to the pond. He accepted the request of the elephants to take the other way, without disturbing the rats.

Mooshakraj was very happy and pleased with Gajraj. He thanked him and promised that the rats would always be ready to help the elephants if needed.

Word-Meanings—**requested** = asked for; **route** = way; **pond** = water body; **promised** = agreed; **disturbing** = harming; **pleased** = highly satisfied; **thanked** = expressed gratefulness; **promised** = gave word; **always** = ever; **ready** = prepared; **assist**; **if needed** = if required.
