A1. There are four types of Taste buds present in our tongue. They are sweet, sour, salty, bitter.

## Q3. What are sense organs? Name them.

A3. The organs through which we get to know about our surroundings are called sense organs. The five sense organs are eyes, ears, nose, tongue and skin.

## Q6. How our eyes see an object?

A6. Working of the eye:

- 1. An object is in front of the eyes.

- 3. The nerves in the eyes send the message to the brain.
- 4. The brain reads the message and enables us to see the object.

#### Q7. How should we take care of our skin?

A7. We can take care of our skin in the following ways we must:

- 1. Always take a bath using soap and water to remove the dirt and sweat from our skin.
- 2. Always wear clean clothes.
- 3. Apply antiseptic lotion on any scratch or cut to keep away germs.

## Q8. How do we hear the sounds falling on our ears?

A8. We can hear the sound falling on our eyes in the following manner:

- 1. The outer ear catches sound from the surroundings and sends them to the inner ear.
- 2. The nerves in the inner ear send the message to the brain.
- 3. The brain reads the messages and enables us to hear the sound.
