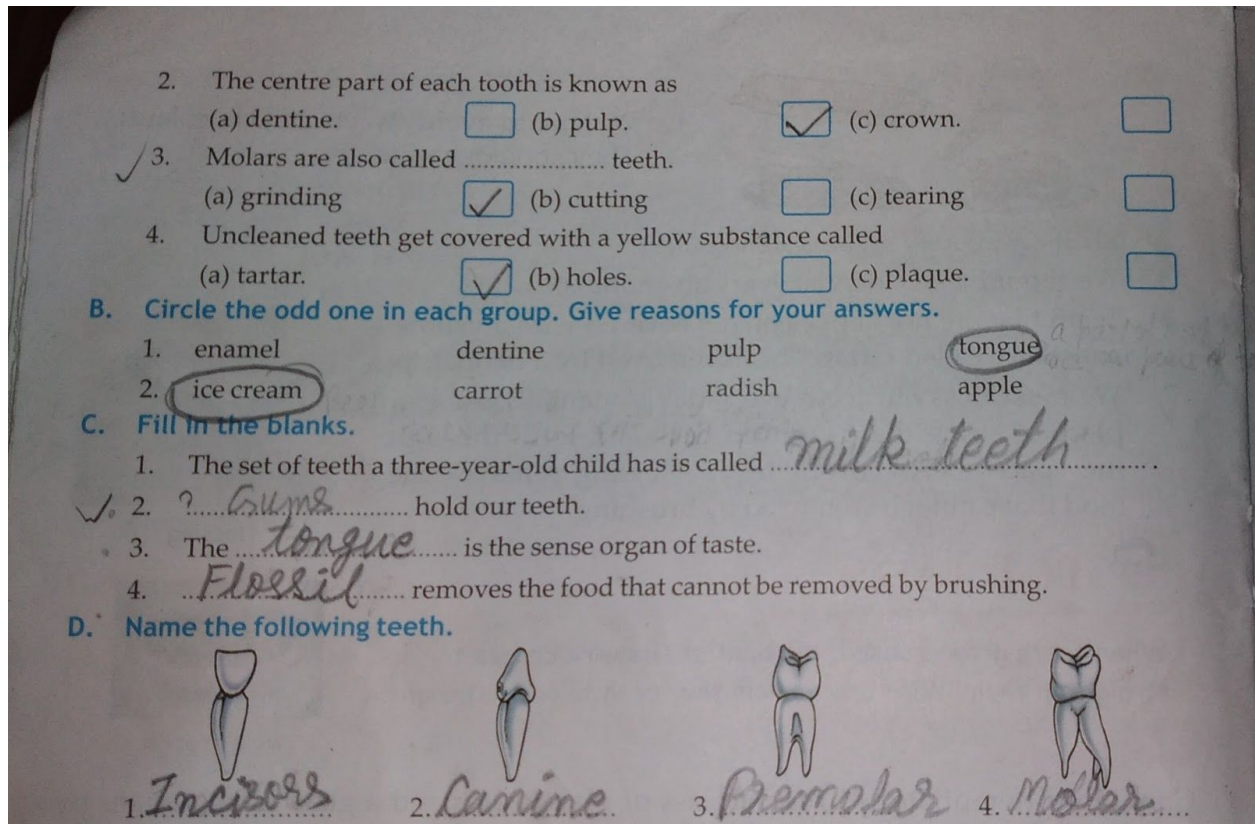

**Q1. What is tartar? How can it be removed?**

A1. Teeth that are not kept clean get covered with a yellow substance called tartar. This is removed by a dentist.

**Q2. What is dental floss?**

A2. A dental floss is a piece of string that is moved back and forth through the spaces between our teeth to remove the stuck food which is not removed by brushing.

**Q1. What are the functions of a) incisors b) canines c) premolars d) molars?**

A1. The functions of the different types of teeth are as follows:

(a) Incisors: They are used to cut and bite food.

(b) Canines: They are used for tearing food.

(c) Premolars : They help in cracking food.

(d) Molars: They help in grinding the food.

**Q2. What are the harmful effects of tooth decay?**

A2. The harmful effects of tooth decay are as follows:

(i) Tooth decay causes toothache.

(ii) A foul smell comes from the mouth.

(iii) This may also lead to stomach disorders.

(iv) It may also result in formation of holes or cavities in the teeth.
