They are tied together with a string and look like a lovely bunch. When the wind blows, the colourful and lovely bunch sways with the wind. During a sunny day, the people gather near his cart to buy them. The colourful balloons in their hands make them happy and one could see them shining bright even from a distance. In the end, the poet wishes that someday the balloon man might set them free high in the sky where all the colourful balloons would sail high and look pretty in the sky.
